

## MTF Fall 2022 Meeting Health Safety Net Q&As October 24, 2022

## Q1. Restrictive Messages 991 / 991 Certain HSN dental services available at community health centers and hospital-based health centers. Does this mean person is not eligible?

A1. HSN coverage only applies to Community Health Centers and hospital-based health centers. If a member has HSN only then they are not eligible (active) under MassHealth. To confirm covered services and benefit limitations utilize the attached <u>HSN fee schedule</u> and <u>HSN Office</u> <u>Reference Manual</u> which is also posted on the portal. \*\* Keep in mind MassHealth is primary and HSN is secondary unless a member has HSN only.

## Q2. Is the \$700.00/year limit on dental cost only for children with CMSP or for all HSN members?

A2. \$750 fiscal year maximum (July 1 - June 30) applies to members under the <u>CMSP (Children's</u> <u>Medical Security</u>) plan for MassHealth and HSN. The benefit limitations and covered services are also in the MassHealth, and HSN Office Reference Manual (page 172) which are posted on the portal <u>www.provider.masshealth-dental.net</u> under "documents", file detail category.

## Q3. Do you have info on that Medicare info you just gave us? That is not the same as assistance programs through MH for Medicare eligible recipients, right?
